-Be prepared to sing 32 bars of a song that demonstrates your range and bring sheet music in the correct key. Accompaniment provided.

-Audition forms are included on the new two pages of this packet and should be fully completed prior to audition. If unable to complete form prior, arrive early to complete.

-Bring a headshot photo if you have one, to attach to form. If not, one will be taken that evening.

-All actors will be notified by Sunday, Nov. 10, via a phone call.

Rehearsals

-Rehearsals are typically scheduled for Sunday through Thursday, but will be set around the schedules of those cast.

-Should you be cast, please make "Side by Side by Sondheim" the priority in your schedule. (*Any expected absences for rehearsals should be noted on the Audition Form. No absences are allowed during run of the show.*)
